



- 1: The legs are red; give me the impression that they are Red Shanks. However, the legs of these waders appear to be shorter than the legs of Red Shanks and their size is also smaller than the Red Shank. Can't see the bill clearly, but I think that they are Terek Sandpipers.
- 2: Bill longer than the plover and curve downward, Curlew Sandpiper.
- 3: Bill longer than the plover and curve upward, Terek Sandpiper.
- 4: The largest wader in the photo, legs appears to be green, long bill, so, Green Shank.
- 5: Size smaller than the Lesser Sandplover, short bill, a tint, brown neck, Red-Necked Stint.
- 6: White underpart, size smaller than, leg shorter than the Green Shank, Spotted Green Shank?
